



Schedule of School Fees for the 2026-2027 Academic Year



1. New student assessment fees*

A non-refundable assessment fee is payable for each child when a place is offered and is invoiced along with the school fees. This fee will be waived for students returning to ICS. This fee covers the assessment of your child(ren)'s appropriate testing, interviews and assessment as needed: It is billed on your invoice as "Assessment": JOD 3066 (Y1-Y13).

Students who join ICS in EY1 or EY2 will pay the assessment when they move to Y1

2. Tuition fees

- Full tuition fees payment must be paid upon receipt of the invoice.
- A student's place for the academic year 2026-2027 (or any subsequent year) shall not be confirmed until all required payment(s) has/have been received in full.
- Any student(s) whose fees remain unpaid shall not be admitted to their classroom(s) on the first day of the new academic year 2026-2027.

3. Bus fees

A non-refundable bus fee is paid in advance for the whole year .

Round-trip fee: JOD 522/student /term

One-way trip fee: JOD 382/student /term

4. Lunch fees

A non-refundable lunch fee is paid in advance.

Registered students: JOD 900/student

5. Conditions of payment for the school fees

Payment of school fees can be settled in Jordanian Dinars or US Dollars, in which case we apply the current official middle USD/JOD exchange rate of 0.708. The school's bank details will be shown on your invoice.

6. Examination board fees

Examination Board fees are not included in the School's tuition fees. Fees for (I)GCSE, A-Level and BTEC examinations are charged separately and payable as required.

7. Textbooks and school activities

Text books, where applicable, are provided by the School. Costs relating to optional trips, special courses, uniforms, certain CCA's, and camp fees are not included in the tuition fees and are paid separately and in advance.

8. Sibling discount

A sibling discount may be offered, at the School's discretion, to families with three or more children enrolled at ICS.

- The discount structure is as follows:
- Third child, a 25% reduction in the annual tuition fee;
- Fourth and subsequent child(ren): a 50% reduction in the annual tuition fee.
- Sibling discounts are applied starting from the youngest enrolled child(ren) in the family.
- ICS reserves the right to review and update the sibling discount structure periodically, provided that any such changes comply with the School's approved fee schedule.

9. Learning Support fees

Learning Support Services (including SEN, EAL, and OT) are charged in addition to the tuition fees. Any adjustment to the level of support following assessment or re-assessment will be reflected in the subsequent invoices.

10. Notification & payment of annual fees

The School reserves the right to offer the place to a new student on the waiting list, in place of an existing student(s,) if the Parent fails to make the required fee payment(s) by the specified deadline. No seat shall be secured without timely payment.

Students will not be admitted to their classrooms on the first day of the new academic year 2026-2027 unless full payment is settled.

11. Partial payments for the term

- Students withdrawing during a term: When the required two-term written notice has been provided, a minimum of 50% of the term's fees will be charged for any student who withdraws partway through a term.
- Request to hold a seat: If the Parent requests that a student's seat be held during a term, meaning the student will not attend classes for part or all the term, while another student on the waiting could otherwise take the seat, the Parent will be responsible for paying the full term's fees to secure the reservation.
- Students joining during a term: If a student joins ICS after a term has begun, the School will charge fees only for the portion of the term the student attends. Fees will be calculated from the student's first day at ICS until the end of that term.

12. Refunding of fees

- All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- The School requires two full terms of written notice in case of withdrawal. Written notice of intention to withdraw at the end of a term must be submitted to the Finance Manager before the last day of the preceding term (i.e., two terms in advance).
- If notice is received after the first day of term, the School reserves the right to charge two full terms' fees in lieu of proper notice.
- This withdrawal policy is applicable in all circumstances, including events of political instability, natural events, or force majeure.
- Any discretionary refund granted by the School shall be subject to a five percent (5%) administrative fee.

13. Non payment of fees:

- If the parents fail to pay all school fees before the start of the academic year or the relevant term, the School shall have no obligation to enrol the student.
- If any outstanding balance arises during the academic year, the student shall not be re-enrolled for the following academic year until all amounts due have been fully settled.

14. Home School Agreement

The admissions process will not be considered complete until the school receives the signed Home School Agreement.

15. No Guarantee of Year-to-Year Enrolment

Re-enrolment from one academic year to the next is not automatic. ICS reserves the right to review and confirm re-enrolment based on compliance with School policies, academic and behavioral expectations, cooperation with School procedures, the student's overall wellbeing, and timely payment of fees.
